Transfer Policy

A student's request to transfer to any NHMCCD Nursing Program will be reviewed on an individual basis by the program director and admissions committee. Class placement is based on previous achievement and if is space available. Admission is considered only if prior program enrollment has been within one (1) year.

The following are required to be considered for transfer:

1. Meet all NHMCCD and program admission requirements.
2. Letter from student requesting transfer to the NHMCCD Nursing Program, including reason for withdrawal from previous program.
3. Submit an application to the nursing program. For the vocational nursing programs, include an official copy of high school transcript or GED certificate as well as other colleges attended.
4. Transcripts showing grades of previous college work.
5. Letter of recommendation from prior nursing program director/s.
6. Copy of skills list demonstrating completion of skills for nursing.
7. Copy of physical examination, including current immunization records.
8. Copy of current CPR certification card.

Students who have had two (2) failures from a comparable nursing program, are not eligible for transfer by may apply as a beginning student.
